4. This PSL is effective from TBA~~6 March 2002~~.
5. This PSL has been approved by the Panel.
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7. If the provisions of this PSL are inconsistent with the provisions of the Code, the provisions of the Code shall prevail to the extent of such inconsistency. If the provisions of this PSL are inconsistent with the provisions of an BSC Procedure or a Code of Practice, the provisions of this PSL shall prevail to the extent of such inconsistency.

~~Version 4.2~~~~Version 4.2~~~~Version 4.1~~Version 4.0**1.3 Registration Obligations****1.3.1 Appointment of Non Half Hourly Data Collector**

1.3.1.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall record sufficient details, received from its Associated Supplier, of its appointment in respect of a SVA Metering System to enable the Non Half Hourly Data Collector to perform its functions as Non Half Hourly Data Collector. These details shall include the relevant SVA Metering System Number, and the Identifiers for the Associated Meter Operator Agent, the Associated Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator, the Associated Public Distribution System Operator at the appropriate GSP Group. The detail shall indicate the Settlement Days for which the Non Half Hourly Data Collector and its Associated Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator are appointed.

1.3.1.2 The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall validate associated details of each SVA Metering System received from its Associated Supplier against Market Domain Data supplied by the Supplier Volume Allocation Agent.

1.3.2 Termination of Appointment of Non Half Hourly Data Collector

1.3.2.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall prepare and maintain plans that will enable its Associated Supplier's obligations under the Code to continue to be met notwithstanding the expiry or termination of the Non Half Hourly Data Collector's appointment as the Non Half Hourly Data Collector. The plans, which the Non Half Hourly Data Collector undertakes to implement on any such expiry or termination, will include the immediate transfer of data and other information to an incoming Non Half Hourly Data Collector appointed by the Associated Supplier or, if the Associated Supplier ceases to be responsible for the relevant SVA Metering System at the same time as the Non Half Hourly Data Collector, to the Panel the event of the Non Half Hourly Data Collector ceasing to trade at the same time as the Supplier.

1.3.2.2 On expiry or termination of the Non Half Hourly Data Collector's appointment as Non Half Hourly Data Collector in respect of a SVA Metering System, the outgoing Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall immediately transfer sufficient data and other information to the incoming Non Half Hourly Data Collector to enable such incoming Non Half Hourly Data Collector to carry out its functions as Non Half Hourly Data Collector in respect of that SVA Metering System.

This clause 1.3.2.2 will be superseded by clause 1.3.2.3.1 with effect from 1st April 2000.

~~1.1.1.3~~1.3.2.3 With effect from 1st April 2000, the following clause 1.3.2.3.1 shall supersede clause 1.3.2.2 above.

1.3.2.3.1 On expiry or termination of the Non Half Hourly Data Collector's appointment as Non Half Hourly Data Collector in respect of a SVA Metering System, the outgoing Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall, upon request, transfer ~~the sufficient data~~ required by BSC Procedure BSCP504 and other information to the incoming Non Half Hourly Data Collector to enable such incoming Non Half Hourly Data Collector to carry out its functions as Non Half Hourly Data Collector in respect of that SVA Metering System.

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~~Version 4.2~~~~Version 4.2~~~~Version 4.1~~Version 4.0**1.3.5 Bulk Change of Agent**

1.3.5.1 Where the associated Supplier chooses to initiate a bulk non-half hourly change of agent application for consideration by the Panel (which may or may not directly involve the Non Half Hourly Data Collector), the Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall proceed in accordance with BSC Procedure BSCP513.

1.3.5.1 Once the bulk change of agent application has been approved by the Panel and where the Non Half Hourly Data Collector is directly involved, the Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall proceed in accordance with BSC Procedure BSCP504.

1.4 Metering Obligations**1.4.1 Meter Details**

1.4.1.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall maintain and (notwithstanding any inconsistency as defined below) utilise records (as updated from time to time) of Metering Equipment Technical Details (including energisation status) received from its Associated Meter Operator Agent for each SVA Metering System for which it is responsible. The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall report to its Associated Supplier any inconsistencies between the Metering Equipment Technical Details received from its Associated Meter Operator Agent and those observed on site or received from its Associated Supplier in the course of carrying out its functions as Non Half Hourly Data Collector.

1.4.1.2 The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall record details of site location and where appropriate communications details as notified to it from time to time by its Associated Supplier for each SVA Metering Systems for which it is responsible. The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall notify its Associated Supplier immediately if these details are not sufficient to enable it to collect metering data in accordance with its functions as Non Half Hourly Data Collector.

1.4.1.3 Upon receipt of such information from its Associated Supplier, the Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall validate against Market Domain Data, record, store and update, details of each SVA Metering System for which it is responsible as follows:-

- Profile Class;
- Standard Settlement Configuration;
- GSP Group;
- Measurement Class; and
- Time Pattern Regime for each Settlement Register of the SVA Metering System.
