1.1.10 Termination of Appointment of Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator

1.1.10.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall prepare and maintain plans that will enable its Associated Supplier's obligations under the Code to continue to be met notwithstanding the expiry or the termination of the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator's appointment as the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator. The plans, which the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator undertakes to implement on any such expiry or termination will include the immediate transfer of data and other information to the Panel and to the Associated Supplier.

1.1.11 Instruction File Processing

1.1.11.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall process instruction files received from its Associated Non Half Hourly Data Collector and from a SMRS in accordance with the BSC Procedure BSCP505.

1.1.11.2 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall investigate the cause of file failures and shall rectify any failures caused by it as soon as reasonably practicable.

1.1.11.3 If an instruction file validation failure is due to a transmission problem, the Non Half Hourly Aggregator shall notify the provider of the reason for the failure and shall request that the file be resent with the same file sequence number.

1.1.11.4 If an instruction file validation error is caused by the provider of the file, the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall notify the provider of the reason for the failure and shall request the provider to send a revised instruction file containing the all instructions required to rectify the situation.

1.1.12 Problem Log

1.1.12.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall establish and use a problem log for the management of failed and discarded instructions and shall maintain the log for audit and control purposes. The log shall hold information in accordance with Appendix 4 about failed or discarded instructions.

1.1.12.2 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall promptly record in the problem log the reasons for failure of failed instructions and the date and time of the latest processing attempt and shall record the instructions to be resolved by the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator and those that have been resolved by it. The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall, record in the problem log the corrective action taken in respect of each resolved instruction failure.

1.1.13 Bulk Change of Agent

1.1.13.1 Where the associated Supplier chooses to initiate a bulk non-half hourly change of agent application for consideration by the Panel (which may or may not directly involve the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator), the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall proceed in accordance with BSC Procedure BSCP513.

1.1.13.2 Once the bulk change of agent application has been approved by the Panel and where the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator is directly involved, the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall proceed in accordance with BSC Procedure BSCP505.

1.2 Market Domain Data Obligations

1.2.1 Market Domain Data

- 1.2.1.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall record and use such Market Domain Data as is considered appropriate by the Panel (having regard to the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator's functions) and shall, in particular, use only Market Domain Data for those items for which there is a Market Domain Data entry.
- 1.2.1.2 On receipt of any new Market Domain Data, the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall find and resolve as soon as reasonably possible any conflicts with existing data in its system caused by the new Market Domain Data.
- 1.2.1.3 In the event of any dispute as to whether an item of Market Domain Data is appropriate or, as the case may be, affects the accuracy of Settlement, the decision of the Panel shall be conclusive.
- 1.2.1.4 Where the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator has loaded the Data Aggregation and Settlements Timetable File, the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall validate this file in accordance with the relevant appendix of BSC Procedure BSCP505.

1.3 Interface to Supplier Meter Registration Services

1.3.1 SMRS Data

- 1.3.1.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall accept instructions from any SMRS and shall promptly input into its Certified processes the data and other information so received.
- 1.3.1.2 Data from a SMRS shall be validated by the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator in accordance with BSC Procedure BSCP505.
- 1.3.1.3 In performing its functions as Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator, the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall treat data or other information received from a SMRS as definitive where it conflicts with data or other information provided to the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator by its Associated Supplier or its Associated Non Half Hourly Data Collector.

1.3.2 Refresh Supplier Meter Registration Service MSID Data

- 1.3.2.1 The Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator shall from time to time request a Full Refresh from a SMRS comprising the complete registration and standing data for all SVA Metering Systems for which the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator is responsible in that SMRS whenever required to ensure the integrity of the Half Hourly Data Aggregator's data base.
