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<p><b>Costs</b></p> <p>£298.00 to amend MDD operational procedures, subject to the comments below.</p>

<p><b>Comments</b></p> <p>The proposal states that the definition for Meter Asset Maintenance (MAM) will be the same as that for Meter Operator Agent (MOA), as currently defined in the BSC, and that there is no proposed change to MDDM for MAM identification. This implies that Meter Asset Maintainers (MAMs) will have a Role Code of M but M would also still be defined as Meter Operator Agent. The SVA Agent requires clarification as to whether the description for Role Code M needs to be amended in MDD.</p> <p>The addition of a new Role Code for Meter Asset Provision (MAP) will require minor amendments to MDD tables before that Role Code can be assigned to MPID's. This work will be carried out by the MDDA at no cost to ELEXON. The Role Code to be used for this new role will need to be agreed with ELEXON.</p> <p>Having discussed the use of 'CUST' as a participant id for MAP's who are also the customer, with Ceri Hughes of ELEXON, the SVA Agent understands that the references to MAP ID are purely for information and that this ID will only be used in the D0150 data flow and the Supplier, NHDC and Distribution systems.</p> <p>There are no application code changes required to Data Marshalling or MDD to accommodate this requirement as specified.</p>
