Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Amendments to BSCP509 following an expert group review of the Market Domain Data process.	
Description of Problem/Issue <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> At the Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG) meeting on 04 March 2008, the SVG agreed that a review of the Market Domain Data (MDD) process should be carried out (paper SVG85/09). The SVG agreed for ELEXON to set up an expert group to review all the current issues and propose solutions as required. The MDD Expert Group identified a number of issues in the MDD process and developed solutions to these issues, a number of which will require changes to process BSCP509 ‘Changes to Market Domain Data’. This Draft Change Proposal (DCP) proposes the necessary amendments to the relevant sections of BSCP509 and Appendix 4.1 as agreed by the MDD Expert Group. The proposed changes are outlined below.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Changes to BSCP509 will bring about improvements and clarity to the process set out in BSCP509 as recommended by the MDD Expert Group.	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> The following sections of BSCP509 will require complete removal from the BSCP, changing or clarification; <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Section 1.5 ‘Associated BSC Procedures’: This section refers to following BSCP11 ‘Trading Queries and Trading Disputes’ procedures in the case where market participants query or dispute a publish of MDD. This procedure is not applicable in the case of an incorrect MDD Publish. The current process will be to remove the queried MDD change via BSCP509 in the next MDD version. This section should be removed from BSCP509. • Appendix 4.1 ‘MDD Entities and Authorisations Route’: Inclusion of footnote for: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ○ Entity 53 - Meter Timeswitch Class (MTC) for Distributor (this entity form indicates that a particular MTC is supported by a Distributor); and ○ Entity 56 - Valid MTC/SSC/LLFC Combinations (this entity form allows the market participant to link Line Loss Factor Classes (LLFC) to valid MTC/Standard Settlement Configuration (SSC) combinations). <p>This would increase clarity for market participants. This update will notify Suppliers to liaise with the Licensed Distribution System Operator (LDSO) before making a formal submission of either Entity forms and to ensure that the correct combinations have been selected before progressing with the MDD process.</p> • Appendix 4.2 ‘MDD Entity Change Request Forms’: F509 form contains a description and justification field, which are duplicates and one should be removed. • Appendix 4.2 ‘MDD Entity Change Request Forms’: F509 form should include Role Code to allow for identification of the MDD change originator. • BSCP509 Appendix: MDD Entity Change Request Forms: Participant Address information
