

Change Proposal – BSCP40/02	CP No: 1281 <i>Version No: v1.0</i> <i>(mandatory by BSCCo)</i>
Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Revenue Protection: requiring the NHHDC to send EAC/AA data to the Supplier via the DTC	
Description of Problem/Issue <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> In accordance with BSCP504 3.6, when an NHHDC receives advice from the Revenue Protection Business, they are required to record an adjustment to the meter advance based on the unrecorded units estimated by the Revenue Protection Business. The NHHDC calculates a new EAC and AA and sends this to the NHHDA. The Supplier also needs to be notified that the NHHDC has calculated a new EAC and AA. Some NHHDCs use the D0019 flow to inform Suppliers via the DTC, but this is not a formal procedure. We believe this approach should be employed consistently by all NHHDC's in order to ensure that Suppliers are kept informed.	
Proposed Solution <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Add the Supplier into the 'TO' field and 'D0019 'Metering System EAC/AA Data' into the 'INFORMATION REQUIRED' field of 3.6.2 in BSCP504.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> This formalises the requirement on the NHHDC to send the new AA and EAC data to the NHHDA and the Supplier via the data flow D0019. Using a recognised data flow (DTC) adds more control and assurance than not having an agreed method of communication for the end-part of the process. The introduction of sending the D0019 to the Supplier does also add additional comfort that the Supplier knows that the request has been handled that what the new calculated AA and EAC is. No change to the DTC is required for the implementation of this CP.	
To which section of the Code does the CP relate, and does the CP facilitate the current provisions of the Code? <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Yes, it better facilitates BSC Section S 2.3.2.	
Estimated Implementation Costs <i>(mandatory by BSCCo)</i> The estimated ELEXON implementation cost is 1 man day, which equates to £220.
