Title Withdrawal of BSCP506 'Calculation and Population of Initial EACs for Non-Half Hourly Metering Systems Registered in SMRS'

Description of Problem/Issue

The purpose of BSCP506 was to calculate and populate the Metering System Identifier (MSID) specific Estimated Annual Consumption (EAC) values, Grid Supply Point (GSP) Group Profile Class Average EAC and GSP Group Profile Class average EAC and associated Average Fraction of Yearly Consumption Values for Non-Half Hourly (NHH) Supplier Volume Allocation (SVA) Metering Systems within a GSP Group for the start up of the 1998 Trading Arrangements.

BSCP506, Section 1.3 states that 'This BSC Procedure is a one off procedure to be used prior to the start of the 1998 Trading Arrangements in each GSP Group'.

This BSCP is no longer in operational use. It is not required for the British Electricity Transmission and Trading Arrangements (BETTA) since initial EACs are already in use in Scotland for the two new Scottish GSP Groups. BSCP516 'Allocation of Profile Classes & SSCs for Non-Half Hourly SVA Metering Systems Registered in SMRS' contains the enduring process to be used from the GSP Group Implementation Date for each Supplier. Therefore BSCP506 should be withdrawn.

Note: there are no Code references to BSCP506 hence no Housekeeping Modification will be required to fully implement this change.

Proposed Solution(s) *(mandatory by originator)*

Withdraw BSCP506 'Calculation and Population of Initial EACs for Non-Half Hourly Metering Systems Registered in SMRS'

BSCP506 is referenced in BSCP504 'Non-Half Hourly Data Collection for SVA Metering Systems Registered in SMRS' in section 1.1:

'For the purposes of initial EAC population within a GSP Group, the EACs used shall be based on BSCP506 - Calculation and Population of Initial EACs for Non-Half Hourly SVA Metering Systems Registered in SMRS.'

This sentence should be removed from BSCP504 as it is no longer relevant.

BSCP506 is also referenced in BSCP535 'Technical Assurance', section 1.6 'Associated BSC Procedures'. The reference to BSCP506 should be removed from here.

Justification for Change *(mandatory by originator)*

If this document is not withdrawn prior to the implementation of BETTA, rebadging changes will be required to it for BETTA. It is not cost effective to make BETTA rebadging changes to a document that is no longer operational and therefore this document should be withdrawn.
