Title Timing of D0170 data request flows	
Description of Problem/Issue <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> BSCP502 'Half Hourly Data Collection for SVA Metering Systems Registered in SMRS' Version 6.0 states in sections 3.2.4 'Change of HHDC for an SVA Metering System' and 3.2.7 'Concurrent Change of Supplier and HHDC for an SVA Metering System' that if required, a new Half Hourly Data Collector (HHDC) Agent may request from the old HHDC Agent (on a D0170 'Request for Metering System Related details' flow) up to 14 months of historic Half Hourly Metered Data, where available, including the final Meter reading and the last physical Meter register reading taken on site, for estimation purposes. The old HHDC Agent is required send this data within five working days of the request, using D0036 'Validated Half Hourly Advances for Inclusion in Aggregated Supplier Matrix' and D0010 'Meter Readings' flows. BSCP502 does not exclude the sending of D0170 flows before the date of change of HHDC. However, as BSCP502 requires the sending of all readings up to this date (and the final meter reading), this will cause an inherent breach of the procedure if the request is sent more than five working days before the date of change. This has been observed as occurring at one HHDC Agent.	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> In order to ensure that the final Meter reading is available for use by the new HHDC, BSCP502 sections 3.2.4 and 3.2.7 should specify in the 'WHEN' column of each procedure (in version 6.0 steps 3.2.4.8 and 3.2.7.8), that the new HHDC does not send the D0170 prior to the HHDC Effective From Date on their D0155 'Notification of Meter Operator or Data Collector Appointment and Terms' flow received from their associated Supplier.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> This will enable the old HHDC to ensure that the final Meter reading can be collected and available to send within the 5 WD timescale specified by BSCP502. This is raised from a BSC Audit market issue. Highlighted in the audit report as Statement of Significant Matter 17.
