Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Clarification of NHHDC obligation to pass EAC/AA data to Suppliers.	
Description of Problem/Issue <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> BSCP504 3.3.11.5 requires that the Non Half Hourly Data Collector (NHHDC) should send an AA and or EAC to the Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator (NHHDA) and Supplier via a Metering System EAC/AA (D0019) dataflow. Footnote 73 to BSCP504 3.3.11.5 states that "the NHHDC will send the data (AA and or EAC) only to their respective Supplier / NHHDA". This requirement would benefit from further differentiation between what should be sent to the old and new Suppliers respectively by the NHHDC (or, where concurrent with a change of NHHDC, by the old and new NHHDCs respectively).	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Clarify that :- <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • the NHHDC (the old NHHDC on concurrent change of Supplier and NHHDC) should send the AA <u>only</u> to the old Supplier <u>only</u>; and • the NHHDC (the new NHHDC on concurrent change of Supplier and NHHDC) should send the associated EAC <u>only</u> to the new Supplier <u>only</u>. where the AA and EAC are those calculated from the Change of Supplier reading.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> This Change Proposal is based on SIR R2106, which was raised following requests by certain participants for clarification of the data passed to Suppliers following processing of the change of Supplier reading. The stated justification for SIR R2106 was that a distinction between old and new Supplier was required to ensure that NHHDCs do not pass confidential data to an incorrect Supplier. Notwithstanding the above justification, a clarification of the EAC/AA data sent to Suppliers will complement the clarification of the EAC/AA data sent to NHHDA's proposed by Change Proposal 913 (see overleaf).

Requested Implementation Date <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Would benefit from being implemented in conjunction with CP913 Reason: This change proposal complements CP913 as both clarify situations in which an AA and EAC may, depending on the recipient, need to be sent individually rather than as an AA/EAC pair.
