Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> New Metering Code of Practice	
Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> There is currently no Code of Practise (CoP) relating to Metering Equipment in the Non-Half Hourly Market as until the present, all Metering Equipment used in this area has been of an Approved Type (by Ofgem) and conforms to British Standard EN 61036. The possibility of New Metering Technology entering the Market in the near future requires the need for a Code of Practice for the Non-Half Hourly Market.	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Write a new Code of Practice, CoP 8 titled 'Code of Practice for the Metering of Energy Imports and Exports via Low Voltage Circuits Fused at 100 Amps or Less per Phase for Non-Half Hourly Settlement Purposes'. This CoP should be written by a group of Industry Experts in this area.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> The need for a New Metering Code of Practice has arisen from the New Metering Technology Working Group. New Technology Meters will have additional facilities to those that are currently in use. Without a Code of Practice for New Technology Meters, there is a danger that during the Change of Supplier Process, the incoming Supplier will not have compatible technologies and infrastructure to support the Metering, thus causing a stranded asset problem. The introduction of a Code of Practice for this area of the market will set a standard interface for New Technology Meters, so reducing the risk of stranded assets. A new CoP will also take account of the potential for the provision of Automatic Meter Readings (AMR).
