Availability of Transmission Company SAA-I014 Reports for all Parties

Description of Change (mandatory by originator)

(1) Settlements Reports for all Trading Parties

The BSC states that settlement reports (SAA-I014 or S0141) for each Party are available to the relevant Trading Party and any Party on request. Such a request is submitted using BSCP41.

A number of Trading Parties have requested the settlement reports for all Parties. As currently implemented this requires the Party to request the report for every other Trading Party individually. The settlements report sent to the Transmission Company (which is also sent to BSCCo), which contains the information for all Parties, cannot be sent to Trading Parties because of a different "role code" (although the concept of a role code does not exist in the BSC). Thus the current procedure will result in a higher administrative burden for both Parties and the Service Provider as well as higher data volumes for providing the same information.

(2) Balancing Mechanism Data

Separately, a number of Parties have expressed dissatisfaction with the ease (or lack thereof) with which Bid-Offer Data can be obtained from the Balancing Mechanism Reporting Service. These Parties require the data in order to undertake analysis of the Balancing Mechanism in order to inform their own decisions re participation.

(3) Historic Balancing Mechanism Data

Parties have requested Balancing Mechanism data retrospectively, again due to the inadequacy of the current BMRS implementation for this purpose.

Proposed Solution(s) (mandatory by originator)

(1) Make the Transmission Company variant of the SAA-I014 (S0142) available to all Parties on request by removing the role code restriction. Alternatively, the data could be made available as a download on the NETA website (a zipped Transmission Company SAA-I014 is approximately 1 Meg including Bid-Offer data and 400kByte without Bid-Offer Data.)

If the Settlement Administration Agent costs are too high and the implementation timescales too long, ELEXON has the data and could possibly make the data available from the ELEXON website or via email.

(2) Balancing Mechanism data is contained in the Interim Information Run of SAA-I014 sent to the Transmission Company (iS0142). Hence availability of this report, as above, provides a solution to this problem.

(3) Until data is available on an ongoing basis, a possible solution is to make available

Balancing Mechanism data from the Go Live Date available on CD-ROM, with monthly updates

Justification for Change (*mandatory by originator*)

This change will allow BSCCo to fulfil its obligations under the code in respect of the availability of Settlements Reports as requested by Parties in a more efficient manner.
