Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> There are 2 possible solutions: <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. reduce the period in which a Trading Query or Trading Dispute may be raised from 3 years to 2 years. This solution would require a modification to para 1.2.5 of Section W: Trading Queries and Trading Disputes;2. extend the data retention period to support the raising of a dispute up to the 3rd anniversary of the Settlement Day to which the Dispute relates. This solution would require a number of SVA Code Subsidiary Documents (listed in NCR250 attached) to be amended.

Description of Proposed Change:

There is an inconsistency between Section W: Trading Queries and Trading Disputes and SVA Code Subsidiary Documents.

Section W of the Code extends the current timescales for raising a Dispute in respect of a Settlement Day from 2 years to 3 years.

SVA Code Subsidiary Documents (Party Service Lines and SVAA Service Lines) currently oblige the SVAA, Suppliers and their Agents to retain data to support Disputes for a period of 28 months.

The following SVA Code Subsidiary Documents will require amendment to address this Code inconsistency:

SVAA Service Line 320 - Disaster Recovery Service and Data Security;

SVAA Service Line 330 - National Support Services;

SVAA Service Line 370 – Miscellaneous Services;

Party Service Line 110 - Meter Operation;

Party Service Line 120 - Non Half-Hourly Data Collection;

Party Service Line 130 - Half Hourly Data Collection;

Party Service Line 140 - Non Half Hourly Data Aggregation;

Party Service Line 150 - Half Hourly Data Aggregation;

Party Service Line 160 - Service Line for the PES Registration Service (PRS);

Party Service Line 170 - Meter Administration.

Parties and Party Agents are invited to assess the impact of extending their data retention requirements in order to support Section W of the Code.

Reason for Proposed Change (Benefits) and/or Implications of not making the Change:

The change will enable BSC Parties and their Agents to support the resolution of disputes raised by Parties up to 3 years after the event as specified in the BSC. Note that this may also require parties to retain data for an additional 8 months and hence all parties should be consulted on this change.

Note

Earlier versions of this NCR focused on the impact on SVAA only. This version of NCR250 extends the scope to cover all SVA Parties, Party Agents and BSC Agents.
