<p>Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>The ECVAA Credit Checking delay functionality should be amended to reflect the enduring requirements of the Balancing and Settlement Code Section M 3.3.5 and 3.3.6 (b).</p> <p><i>This CP has been raised from NCR342</i></p>	
<p>Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>The BSC defines the Credit Default Refusal Periods and Credit Default Rejection Periods as not commencing until Credit Checking for the associated Settlement Periods has completed where there is a delay to the ECVAA Credit Checking processing. Therefore this requirement should be reflected in ECVAA functionality.</p>	
<p>Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>The ECVAA delay handling process is currently not operating in accordance with the enduring process as defined in the Balancing and Settlement Code Section M 3.3.5 and 3.3.6 (b) due to the Suspension Period (BSC Section E). The current operation is defined in BSC Section M 3.3.8 and is required to be superseded by enduring functionality under BSC Section E.</p>
