#### **BRIEF DESCRIPTION OF CANDIDATES' BACKGROUND**

## **Andrew Colley**

Andrew has nearly 30 years of operational, development and management experience within the wholesale trading and settlements arrangements, with detailed involvement in major stages of GB electricity market liberalisation and reform for SSE, including:

- Development of privatisation vesting, Final Metering Scheme and 1994 expansion of supply competition arrangements
- Adaptation and operation of SSE's Back Office Trading agreements, systems and processes to accommodate 1998 expansion of supply competition, and subsequently NETA
- Management and implementation of the BETTA arrangements for SSE's Generation and Supply businesses, covering all obligations arising under the GB BSC, CUSC, Grid Code as well as the orderly run down of Scottish Electricity Settlements
- Current responsibility within SSE for the development of the BSC and associated Trading Arrangements.

Andrew is currently an industry elected member of the BSC Panel, having been first elected in 2010, with 4 years prior experience as Panel Alternate. He currently acts as the Panel Sponsor for PAB and is also a member of the Credit Committee.

Additionally, Andrew has assisted in and remains active in the development of numerous BSC modifications and issues, as well as previously having served as a member of the ISG, TDC and Q8 Committees for a number of years.

His wider recent roles and responsibilities have been and remain varied, providing a broad range of experience, ranging from management and advice supporting SSE's development of participation in market development opportunities, to review of and participation in ongoing European and GB energy regulation and policy developments.

### **Stuart Cotten**

Stuart joined the energy industry in 2001 and has been involved in BSC matters from the start. His career began in a trading support function, before moving into gas and electricity contract management and then into energy market regulation and policy.

As Head of Regulation and Compliance for Drax Power Limited, Stuart is primarily responsible for GB wholesale electricity market arrangements and their development. Over the last nine years, he has been an active participant in government, regulator and industry-led expert groups, including DECC's Capacity Market Expert Group and Ofgem's Future Trading Arrangements Forum.

Stuart has also served on a variety of industry committees, including the APX Market Development Advisory Board, the CUSC Governance Standing Group (GSG) and Energy UK's Generation Committee.

Stuart has been a BSC Panel Member since 2010. Throughout this period he has been a member of the Credit Committee and Panel Sponsor to the Trading Disputes Committee (TDC).

# **Mitch Donnelly**

Mitch began work in the energy industry in 1998 initially as an analyst with BG Storage before moving to Transco and then British Gas where he has held a number of roles including:

- The integration of the Enron Direct and Electricity Direct settlement systems and processes following their acquisition by Centrica
- The development of British Gas settlement systems and processes to support Smart metering roll out including managing relationships with Supplier Agents and TPIs
- Leading the operational and regulatory teams responsible for the Balancing and Settlement Code and Gas Uniform Network Code and Distribution Connection Use of Service Agreement
- Supporting the development and roll out of a number of specialist products including Time of Use, Smart Homes, Microgeneration and community energy.

Mitch is currently the head of UK Energy Settlements which encompasses a range of responsibilities including BSC and UNC compliance and performance, Supplier Agent management, leading the transition into Half Hourly Settlement and the implementation of project Nexus.

He has been a member of the Performance Assurance Board since 2009 and is a member of the TDC. He has also previously served as a member of SVG, PSRG and UMSUG, as well as participating in numerous modification workgroups and issue groups.
