Npower Dave Smith	Yes	-	Any other comments - Generally npower are happy with the proposed changes to the Codes of Practice as it will enable a consistent approach to be taken and will allow for all suitable metering to be used. The only comments we would like to make are there is no mention of the Compliance and Protocol Approvals List within the CP. The CP Participant Impact Matrix indicates that this only impacts NHHMOAs, is this correct? Currently a HHMOA would need to seek a metering dispensation to use certain meters in the Half-Hourly world whereas this would not be the case with the implementation of this CP. We would then expect these meters to be included on the Compliance and Protocols Approvals List but this may be left to the discretion of individual meter manufacturers, Meter Operators and HHDCs via BSCP601. Will this CP impact the Compliance and Protocols Approvals List?
