<b>Title of Modification Proposal</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> : Facility to permit BSCCo to undertake the role of the Profile Administrator

<b>Description of Proposed Modification</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> A Modification to allow BSCCo, or any of its subsidiary companies, to undertake the role of the Profile Administrator.	
<i>Description of Issue or Defect that Modification Proposal Seeks to Address (mandatory by originator)</i>  The Profile Administrator is currently defined as a BSC Agent within Section E of the Balancing and Settlement Code (the Code). As such, the role of the Profile Administrator cannot be undertaken by any Party, nor BSCCo or any of its subsidiary companies.  The services of the Profile Administrator are currently being undertaken by Electricity Association Services Limited (EASL), appointed by ELEXON. EASL has informed ELEXON that as a result of a restructuring process, it wishes to cease acting as Profile Administrator during 2003. The earliest EASL can terminate its agreement with BSCCo is 6 months from the date notice in writing is given to BSCCo (and thereafter they would be required to give up to 12 months of exit management). No such notice has been given as at today's date. If such notice were given, BSCCo could tender out the Profile Administrator service but, as far as BSCCo is aware, the service cannot easily be purchased "off-the-shelf" elsewhere in a timely manner.  The data provided by the Profile Administrator is an integral part of the Settlement system underpinning the non Half Hourly Supplier Volume Allocation calculation. EASL's intention to cease providing the service could mean that it would not be possible to procure, at a reasonable cost, and in a timely manner, an alternative independent service provider with the relevant expertise to undertake the role of the Profile Administrator. An issue exists in that if no service is in place to provide the data, the accuracy of the Settlement system would be compromised and BSCCo would be in breach of its obligations under the Code.  This Modification Proposal, is therefore intended to allow BSCCo flexibility in the way in which it is able to secure the service of the Profile Administrator, by specifically permitting it to assume the Profile Administrator service in the event that a commercial decision to do so is made.
