

<b>Change Proposal – BSCP40/02</b>	CP No: 1270  <i>Version No: 1.0</i> <i>(mandatory by BSCCo)</i>
<b>Title</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Improvements to the Market Domain Data Process	
<b>Description of Problem/Issue</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  At its meeting on 4 March 2008, the Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG) agreed that a review of the Market Domain Data (MDD) process should be carried out (see paper <a href="#">SVG85/09</a> ). The SVG agreed that ELEXON should set up an expert group to review all the current issues and to propose improvements.  The resulting MDD Expert Group (MDDEG) developed solutions to a number of identified issues in the MDD process. CP1270 has been raised to progress the amendments to BSCP509 ‘Changes to Market Domain Data’ and BSCP509 Appendix ‘MDD Entity Change Request Forms’ which support the expert group’s agreed solutions. Further information on the group’s conclusions can be found in paper <a href="#">SVG92/04</a> .	
<b>Proposed Solution</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  In line with the group’s conclusions, the following sections of BSCP509 should either be removed, amended or clarified: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• <b>Section 1.5 ‘Associated BSC Procedures’:</b> This section refers to BSCP11 ‘Trading Queries and Trading Disputes’. However, BSCP11 is not applicable to the MDD process since, if an error is identified in an MDD Publish,<sup>1</sup> a process already exists in BSCP509 to correct the error in the next MDD version. The reference to BSCP11 should therefore be removed from Section 5.1 of BSCP509. Redundant references to BTDP38, BSCP511, BSCP512 and BSCP531 (and their associated footnote) should also be removed from this section as these documents are no longer active.</li> <li>• <b>Appendix 4.1 ‘MDD Entities and Authorisations Route’:</b> A footnote should be included for:             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Entity 53 - Meter Timeswitch Class (MTC) for Distributor (this entity form indicates that a particular MTC is supported by a Distributor); and</li> <li>○ Entity 56 - Valid MTC/SSC/LLFC Combinations (this entity form allows the market participant to link Line Loss Factor Classes (LLFC) to valid MTC/Standard Settlement Configuration (SSC) combinations).</li> </ul>             The footnote will highlight to Suppliers that they should liaise with the relevant Licensed Distribution System Operator (LDSO) before making a formal submission of either of these two entity forms to BSCCo. This will help to ensure that the correct/valid combinations have been selected before beginning the MDD change request process.           </li> <li>• <b>Appendix 4.2 ‘MDD Entity Change Request Forms’:</b> The F509 form contains a ‘Reason for Change’ field and a ‘Justification’ field, which will invite duplication of information. The ‘Justification’ field should therefore be removed.</li> </ul>	

<sup>1</sup> An MDD Publish refers to the distribution of all MDD flows to participants by the Supplier Volume Allocation Agent (SVAA).

- **Appendix 4.2 ‘MDD Entity Change Request Forms’:** The F509 form should include a ‘Role Code’ field to allow for identification of the MDD change originator.

The following sections of BSCP509 Appendix also require amending or updating:

- **BSCP509 Appendix: MDD Entity Change Request Forms:** Participant Address information should be updated by making ‘Address Line 1’ of the MDD Entity 45 form a mandatory field to populate the Participant Name. The remaining lines will then be followed by the address details.
- **BSCP509 Appendix: MDD Entity Change Request Forms:** A check box should be added for the Originator to confirm that approval/consent has been provided by the owner of the Data Item if it does not belong to the Originator.
- **BSCP509 Appendix: MDD Entity Change Request Forms:** Examples in the Entity forms should be reviewed to ensure that they remain the clearest and most correct examples, given the amount of time which has passed since they were originally drafted into the BSCP.

**Justification for Change** *(mandatory by originator)*

Changes to BSCP509 will bring about improvements and additional clarity to the MDD process as recommended by the MDDEG.

**To which section of the Code does the CP relate, and does the CP facilitate the current provisions of the Code?** *(mandatory by originator)*

CP1270 will facilitate Section 5.1 of Annex S-2 ‘Supplier Volume Allocation Rules’.

**Estimated Implementation Costs** *(mandatory by BSCCo)*

ELEXON implementation cost: 3.5 man days of effort (equating to £770).  
CP1270 has no impact on any BSC Agents.
