

Change Proposal – BSCP40/01	CP No: 1165 <i>Version No: 1.0</i>
Title: Removal of the Requirement to Report Valid Excessive AA’s to Suppliers on a Daily Basis	
Description of Problem/Issue	
<p>BSCP 504 3.3.11.7 states that within 1 working day of determining whether an excessively large AA is valid, notification should be sent to the relevant Supplier.</p> <p>In practise this will mean a daily communication (not via the Data Transfer Network) to the Supplier detailing a number of MSID’s and their present EAC/AA values. Such information in this format is cumbersome and time consuming for the NHHDC to collate and send, while the Supplier is unlikely to review this data on a daily basis.</p>	
Proposed Solution	
<p>The current requirement in BSCP 504 3.3.11.7 should be replaced with an obligation to provide a monthly report of all excessively large AA’s to the Supplier, where requested by the Supplier. It should be recognised that any invalid data identified by the NHHDC in the first instance is dealt with under the previous step 3.3.11.6 and resolved via the 3.3.8.3 Withdrawal of Meter Reading process. The details issued in 3.3.11.7 are therefore of less immediate concern to the Supplier as only valid data will have been processed.</p>	
Justification for Change	
<p>The present requirement leads only to inefficient processes for NHHDC Agents and Suppliers or indeed a BSC non-compliance. The issue of whether valid excessive AA’s indicate a need to change profile class is mitigated by the annual report of CoPC candidates from the NHHDC and the monthly report from NHHDA. Both Suppliers and their NHHDC Agents review this report monthly.</p>
