

## Change Proposal – F40/01

### **Title** *(mandatory by originator)*

Removal of particular requirements pertaining to register readings in the Half Hourly Market to improve Settlement efficiency (Part 2 of 3).

### **Description of Problem/Issue** *(mandatory by originator)*

The objectives of the BSC are not being fulfilled to the expected standard; these requirements have been discussed at various Industry forums in order to determine their: - value to the Settlement process, the practicalities of the requirements and the feasibility of performing each process.

Following initial discussion at the Supplier Agent Forum and subsequent discussions with other DCs, this CP (one of three) has been raised to address each of the requirements and the issues surrounding these.

#### **Issue:**

BSCP502 "Half Hourly Data Collection", describes various situations where an "initial" or "final" meter readings are required to be obtained and processed under different circumstances.

"HHDC Agent to receive the initial/final Meter register readings (or notification that the Meter register reading not obtainable) from the MOA on a D0010 flow (or D0002 flow respectively) and send this on the Supplier and LDSO on the same flow:

- Section 3.2.1 – New Connection
- Section 3.3.1&2 – Change of Measurement Class
- Section 3.3.6 – Reconfiguration or Replacement of Metering System"

A HHDC cannot add any value to the process in which they receive a D0010 from the HHMO and subsequently forwards this same information on the same flow to the LDSO and Supplier. This indirect routing of information can only add delay/potentially terminate the process: it is believed to have been introduced, solely due to the fact that the DTC currently does not support the transfer of a D0010 from the MO to these other Parties. In this process the HHDC is required to bear the associated DTN costs for the forwarding of a flow, generated by another Party, without intervening with it or adding any value to the process.

### **Proposed Solution(s)** *(mandatory by originator)*

It is proposed that a change be raised against the DTC to facilitate the sending of a D0010 directly from the MO to both the Supplier and the LDSO, thus enabling the information to be sent direct to the relevant Parties. The requirement for HHDC action within BSCP502 (Sections 3.2.1, 3.3.1, 3.3.2 and 3.3.6) can therefore be removed and BSCP514 amended to describe the action required by the MO.

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<b>Justification for Change (mandatory by originator)</b> Responsibility and costs for the transfer of data should lie with the Party who generates the information. Third party action which does not add any value to the process can only be detrimental both in terms of additional processing time and also the potential for the entire process to fail.
