<b>Title</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Correcting MDDM and SVAA Terminology	
<b>Description of Problem/Issue</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  <p>One of the responsibilities of the Supplier Volume Allocation Agent (SVAA) is to maintain Market Domain Data (MDD). In carrying out this activity, the SVAA acts as the Market Domain Data Manager (MDDM) and has a specific Market Participant Role Code registered in MDD that relates to this activity.</p> <p>As part of the procurement phase of Project Isis, ELEXON has identified that the use of the terms 'SVAA' and 'MDDM' in the SVA Data Catalogue and associated BSCPs is not always accurate, and as a result it can be unclear whether a process is meant to involve the SVAA or MDDM role. This can have practical implications when handling MDD-related communications.</p> <p>ELEXON has carried out a review of the SVA Data Catalogue to identify instances where data flows are not using the correct SVAA/MDDM terminology, or are not giving an accurate reflection of flow usage as required by the BSCPs. ELEXON has also checked the Data Catalogue for any other non-material errors that may be resolved at the same time.</p>	
<b>Proposed Solution</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  <p>The SVA Data Catalogue should be modified to correctly identify the SVAA or MDDM as the sender or recipient of MDD-related data flows. The BSCPs associated with those flows should be then amended in line with the revised Catalogue on an opportune basis as and when they are modified for more material changes.</p> <p>Proposed changes to the SVA Data Catalogue are provided in Attachment A.</p> <p>The associated changes to the BSCPs are described in Attachment B. Please note that CP1249 would not implement these changes; ELEXON will add these minor alterations to its housekeeping register and they will be implemented on an opportune basis.</p>	
<b>Justification for Change</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  <p>The SVAA uses the MDDM role code ('U') when issuing or receiving MDD-related data flows. The documentation needs to correctly identify those instances where this code is used; otherwise there is a risk that MDD will not be received properly.</p> <p>While this change should not impact any existing participants (most of the flows affected are the manual 'P-flows'), new entrants (whether BSC Parties or BSC Agents) will benefit from having a more accurate view of the settlement requirements and will be better able to design their processes accordingly.</p>	
<b>To which section of the Code does the CP relate, and does the CP facilitate the current provisions of the Code?</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  <p>Section S 4.1 – Functions of the Supplier Volume Allocation Agent</p>	
<b>Estimated Implementation Costs</b> <i>(mandatory by BSCCo)</i>  <p>The estimated ELEXON Implementation cost is 2 ELEXON Man Days which equates to £440.</p>
