

<b>Change Proposal – BSCP40/02</b>	<p>CP No: 1237</p> <p><i>Version No: 1.0</i> <i>(mandatory by BSCCo)</i></p>
<p><b>Title</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>Movement of functional requirements from PSL160 to BSCP501 following the creation of generic non-functional PSL100.</p>	
<p><b>Description of Problem/Issue</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>The Code Subsidiary Document (CSD) review highlighted that there is a large amount of duplication between the requirements contained in Party Service Lines (PSLs) and the corresponding Balancing and Settlement Code Procedures (BSCPs).</p> <p>During a consultation as part of the CSD Review, industry participants were asked whether the functional requirements of PSLs should be merged into the appropriate BSCPs and a single PSL created to contain the non-functional requirements relevant to all Party Agents. The majority of respondents to the consultation agreed with this recommendation. The Panel was asked to agree the recommendations of the CSD Review and the CSD Architecture Principles Document at its meeting on 8 June 2006 (Panel paper 115/08). The Panel agreed that a single PSL should be created containing the non-functional requirements for all Parties, SVA Party Agents and CVA MOAs; and that the functional requirements in the existing PSLs should be merged into the relevant BSCPs.</p> <p>A single generic non-functional PSL (PSL100 ‘Generic Non Functional Requirements for Licensed Distribution System Operators and Party Agents’) was approved under CP1182 ‘Creation of a Generic Party Service Line’, and was implemented in November 2007.</p> <p>Following on from CP1182, this CP1237 proposes that the functional requirements currently contained in PSL160 ‘Supplier Meter Registration Service’ should be moved into BSCP501 ‘Supplier Meter Registration Service’.</p> <p>The scope of this CP is limited to moving the location of the functional requirements from PSL160 to BSCP501, and it is not intended to represent a review of the nature of these requirements. Industry views are therefore sought only on the appropriateness of the new location of the requirements, and not on the appropriateness of the requirements themselves.</p>	
<p><b>Proposed Solution</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>Changes should be made to BSCP501 to include the functional requirements which are currently contained in PSL160. A ‘mapping matrix’ which shows the new BSCP501 location of each existing PSL requirement is included as Attachment 1 to this CP. Draft redlined changes to BSCP501 are provided as Attachment 2. Note that no changes have been proposed to the workflow diagrams in BSCP501, since all workflow diagrams are being removed from the BSCPs on an opportune basis each time a new BSCP version is implemented (via approved CP1176). The workflow diagrams in BSCP501 will therefore be separately removed when CP1237 is implemented (or earlier, if another change is implemented in the BSCP prior to CP1237).</p> <p>Consequential changes will be required to Section 12 of the Self Assessment Document (SAD) in BSCP537 ‘Qualification Process for SVA Parties, SVA Party Agents and CVA MOAs’ Appendix 1,</p>	

to replace existing references to PSL160 with references to BSCP501 and/or PSL100 as appropriate. Draft redlined changes to the SAD are provided as Attachment 3.

A consequential change is also required to Section 2.12 of BSCP533 Appendix B 'PARMS Calculation Guidelines', in order to replace the existing generic reference to 'the approach taken in the Party Service Lines' with a reference to PSL100 and the relevant BSCPs. Draft redlined changes to BSCP533 Appendix B are provided as Attachment 4.

Following a review of the contents of BSCP510 'The Provision of Sampling Data to the Profile Administrator', BSCP513 'Bulk Change of NHH Supplier Agent' and the main body of BSCP537 (which are all referenced within PSL160), it is not believed that any changes are required to these BSCPs as a result of CP1237.

Once CP1237 is implemented, a housekeeping Modification Proposal will be required to update references to PSL160 within the BSC before PSL160 can be entirely removed.

**Justification for Change** (*mandatory by originator*)

This CP will remove the duplication between PSL160 and BSCP501, and will mean that Supplier Meter Registration Agents (SMRAs) will only have to look in one type of CSD to find the functional requirements relating to their role. This may be particularly useful to new entrants. In conjunction with CP1182, it will also reduce the cost associated with preparing and maintaining numerous and duplicated PSLs.

**To which section of the Code does the CP relate, and does the CP facilitate the current provisions of the Code?** (*mandatory by originator*)

CP1237 will facilitate the provisions of Section J of the Code.

**Estimated Implementation Costs** (*mandatory by BSCCo*)

The estimated ELEXON implementation costs for CP1237 are £220 (equivalent to 1 man days of effort).
