#### **2.12 Receipt and Sent dates**

The document refers to a number of start and end events that are associated with the receipt and sending of data flows. In accordance with the approach taken in ~~the~~ Party Service Lines 100 'Generic Non Functional Requirements for Licensed Distribution System Operators and Party Agents' and the relevant BSCPs, wherever the Data Transfer Network is used for transfer then the receipt/send boundaries are measured using the date/timestamp that is inserted at the Gateway.
