Title: Clarification of data requirements in the transfer of Metering System Related Details during a Change of Half Hourly Data Collector (HHDC) process.	
Description of Problem / Issue During the change of HHDC process, when requested, the old HHDC will transfer Half Hourly (HH) Metered Data (on the D0036 'Validated Half Hourly Advances for Inclusion in Aggregated Supplier Matrix') and send the last physical Meter reading and the final Meter reading (on the D0010 'Meter Readings') to the new HHDC. With regard to the Meter readings provided on Metering Systems with electronic cumulative reading available during the remote collection process, there some ambiguity as to whether these should form part of the Meter history sent. As a result, at least one HHDC believes that all cumulative totals during its appointment to a Metering Point should be sent/received as part of the transfer of Meter history.	
Proposed Solution(s) BSCP502 requires a footnote added to section 3.2.4.8 and 3.2.7.8 (references taken from version 9.0 of BSCP502) that details the requirement to only send the final Meter reading, which may constitute the last cumulative total reading or manual reading made by the HHDC and the last physical Meter register reading made. It should also state clearly that previous cumulative total reads are not required as part of this data transfer.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> HHDCs have varied expectations and processes for the receipt and sending of Meter history. Sending cumulative total readings for the entire appointment life time is superfluous, adds to file transfer times and is not required to ensure that validation checks can be performed by the new HHDC.
