

<b>Change Proposal – F40/01</b>	<b>CP No: 1029</b> <i>Version Number</i>
<b>Title: Enhancement to Business Process Model to allow searches for references</b>	
<p><b>Description of Problem/Issue</b></p> <p>In the Business Process Model (BPM), references for processes are added to the description. This hasn't been done consistently, so there are approximately a quarter of the processes without references. By including the references in the description there is no easy way of searching for the references, and it isn't possible to start with a reference and find which areas of the BPM model those processes within that reference.</p>	
<p><b>Proposed Solution(s)</b></p> <p>The BPM should be upgraded to version 9, in order to allow user defined associations, to allow associations to a new object type – reference(s).</p> <p>The object type reference should be created within the BPM, and a reference created for each section of the BSC and each Code Subsidiary Document. Where applicable, each process, organisation and event should then be associated to one or more references. When the model is published, the publication set should be amended in order to publish the references.</p>	
<p><b>Justification for Change</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p><i>This change will allow users to start with a reference, and find all the diagrams which model the processes within that reference. For those working on the BPM, it will highlight any gaps – areas which are not modelled but should be. It will also make the BPM more user friendly, allowing users to find the section they are looking for a lot more quickly. Impact Assessments should be a lot easier – for example there are 34 processes that reference BSCPs 26 and 526, which are being merged into one BSCP. The only way to find the impacted processes is to open each one separately, and there are nearly 700. This change could allow this to be determined very quickly.</i></p>
