

Change Proposal – F40/01 (Page 1 of 2)	CP No: 916 <i>(mandatory by BSCCo)</i>
Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Timing of the SAAI006 flow from the Interconnector Administrator	
Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Section 3 of BSCP 04 reference 3.1.1 obliges the Interconnector Administrator to send the Expected Transfers for each Interconnector BM Unit to the SAA by 16.00 on the first working day following the Settlement Day. Section R7.4.1 of the Code requires the activities that culminate in the sending of the Expected Transfers (File reference SAA i006) to the SAA are completed by the end of the next Business Day following the Settlement Day. Section R7.4.3 requires the Interconnector Administrator to send the SAA I006 file to the SAA in accordance with BSCP04. The Interconnector Administrator can therefore be compliant with the Code but non-compliant with BSCP 04 if the file is sent between 16.00 and 24.00 on the Business Day following the Settlement Day.	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> It is suggested that this inconsistency should be resolved by changing the obligation in BSCP 04. In Section 3.1 of the BSCP table reference 3.1.1 requires the Expected Transfer for each Interconnector BM unit to be sent to the SAA 'By 16.00 on the WD following the SD'. It is suggested that this text should be changed to read 'By 24.00 on the WD following the SD'. As a consequence table reference 3.3 will need updating. A new requirement needs to be incorporated into the table for a IA to contact ELEXON if they want to revise BM Unit volumes after the IISR for the relevant Settlement Day. PLEASE NOTE: This CP should be progressed with CP915 that addresses a problem with the manner in which the SAA processes late and revised SAA I006 files from the Interconnector Administrators.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> There is an inconsistency between the BSC and the requirements in BSCP04. The Trading Disputes Committee has explicitly requested that the inconsistency is resolved.
