

<b>Change Proposal – F40/01</b>	CP No:1100  <i>Version No: 1.0</i>
<b>Title</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Removal of generic Metering Dispensations from Codes of Practice 3 and 5.	
<b>Description of Problem/Issue</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> The Codes of Practice (CoPs) currently have generic Metering Dispensations published as appendices, although in practise the only affected CoPs are CoP3 and CoP5. Whenever there is a new generic Metering Dispensation approved, the CoPs should be amended via BSCP40 'Change Management', i.e. a Change Proposal (CP) must be raised and progressed. The publishing of generic dispensations in CoPs would be carried out as opportune. Since CoPs are rarely updated, there are currently a number of generic dispensations that have not been published in the appropriate CoP.	
<b>Proposed Solution(s)</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Rather than amend the CoPs every time there is a new generic dispensation, BSCCo should publish these on the Metering Dispensations section of the BSC Website and advise the industry of this. This process should be included in BSCP32 'Metering Dispensations'. The CoPs would have a general statement with regard to generic dispensations to say that these are contained on the BSC Website, for completeness. Generic dispensations are approved by the appropriate Panel Committee, so participants should feel comfortable that removing the process by which the Panel Committee approves a CP to include the generic dispensation in a CoP does not remove the Panel Committees obligations to initially approve the generic dispensation.	
<b>Justification for Change</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> This change will save costs for Parties and ELEXON by reducing need to raise Change Proposals every time there is a new generic dispensation. It will also mean that all generic dispensations can be published in one easy to find place. This change was supported by the BSCP32 operational review group.
