Title *(mandatory by originator)*

Requirement for NHH Data Collector to provide latest EAC to new NHH Data Aggregator on change of NHHDA.

Description of Change *(mandatory by originator)*

On change of NHH Data Aggregator (NHHDA) the NHH Data Collector (NHHDC) should send the latest Estimated Annual Consumption (EAC) to the new NHHDA. Failure to do so by the Initial Settlement Data Aggregation Run for the effective date of the new NHHDA's appointment will result in a Default EAC being used in settlement.

BSCP504 section 3.2.5 describes the requirements for sending AA and EAC data to the new and old NHHDA's in terms of meter advance periods ending before, on or after the appointment date. There is no explicit requirement to send the latest EAC in the event that no reading has been taken on or around the appointment date of the new NHHDA.

Proposed Solution(s) *(mandatory by originator)*

Clarify BSCP504 by the addition of an explicit requirement in sections 2.2.5 / 3.2.5 that on notification of a change of NHHDA, the NHHDC should send the latest EAC to the new NHHDA. (This EAC should already have been sent to the old NHHDA). This EAC should be sent no later than [8] working days after the effective date of the new NHHDA appointment.

Move the content of sections 3.2.5.2 to 3.2.5.4 to section 3.3.11. This is on the basis that these actions relate to readings taken (or corrections made) after the change of NHHDA has occurred. Since a subsequent reading may be taken some time (possibly greater than a year) after the change of NHHDA, these requirements do not strictly relate to the change of NHHDA. Every time an AA and/or EAC is sent by the NHHDC, the NHHDC should ensure that they are sent to the relevant NHHDA (s). Include a cross-reference in section 3.2.5 to 3.3.11, to cover the eventuality that a reading is taken prior to the latest EAC being sent.

Justification for Change *(mandatory by originator)*

A majority of NHHDCs are understood to have processes in place to send the latest EAC on notification of a change of NHHDA and thus will not be impacted by the proposed change. Ensuring that any remaining NHHDCs (plus any new entrants to the market) send the latest EAC, will mitigate against the use of Default EACs in settlement.
