<p>Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Inclusion of Credit Assessment QCE in ECVAA I-014 Report for a Parties Production and Consumption Account and Reporting of GC and DC values for each BM Unit in a CRA Report.</p>	
<p>Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>Change contents of ECVAA I-014 Report</p> <p>Introduce new CRA Report to contain details of GC, DC and CALF for each BM Unit and Effective from dates.</p>	
<p>Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>It is proposed that the ECVAA I-014 report (or a new one if it is easier or cheaper to implement that way) should contain the value of CAQCE for each Energy Account belonging to the Party. Consideration should also be given to reporting to the cumulative CAQCE_{aj} value over the calculation period together with the cumulative value of Contract Notifications over the period (this would allow sight of whether the increase or decrease of the % of Credit Cover utilised was a result of changes to CALF or DC or GC values or a result of changes in Contract Notification Volumes.</p> <p>A new CRA Report would provide data on GC, DC and CALF values and Effective From Dates each time the data changed (appeals, new Season data or increases within Season).</p>	
<p>Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>At present the ECVAA I-014 Report contains a value of CAQCE at the Party level for each half hour but contains no supporting information as to how this was derived. Experience of trying to resolve differences between our own calculation and those of the Central Systems has shown that it is a laborious process as the Central systems do not hold any intermediate calculations. The more BM Units that a Party is either the Lead or Subsidiary for, the greater the problem.</p>
