<b>Title</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> <b>AMENDMENT TO ECVNA AUTHORISATION TERMINATION REQUEST FORM BSCP71/03</b>	
<p><b>Description of Change</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>At present an ECVNA Authorisation Termination request can be completed by one counterparty and sent to CRA for termination and the pairings are therefore terminated. An ECVNA Authorisation Request form requires the signature and therefore the authorisation of both parties.</p> <p>It would be prudent if any Termination request required the signature and therefore the approval of both parties concerned in line with all Authorisation requests. This would reduce the risk of any relationship being terminated in error and without the knowledge of the other counterparty.</p>	
<p><b>Proposed Solution(s)</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>BSCP71/03 ECVNA AUTHORISATION TERMINATION REQUEST FORM MUST BE COMPLETED AND SIGNED BY BOTH PARTIES BEFORE CRA/LOGICA WILL ACTION ANY TERMINATION REQUEST.</p>	
<p><b>Justification for Change</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Reduce risk of ECVNA authorisation's being terminated in error.</li> <li>• Dis-allow the termination without the knowledge of both parties.</li> <li>• Reduces the risk of potential contract imbalances where there is volume remaining on an Energy Account are more than 7 days out (Which would be highlighted by the I022 report)</li> </ul>
