<p>Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>Improvement to process relating to Metering System Proving Tests.</p>	
<p>Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>When a proving test is carried out on a Metering System, the Meter Operator Agent (MOA) informs the Half Hourly Data Collector (HHDC), the Supplier and the Public Distribution System Operator (PDSO) of the outcome (in the case of a failure, only HHDCs are informed). However, there are no procedures in place to cover the case where no notification is received from the MOA on the outcome of the proving test. At present, HHDCs assume that the proving test was successful and use the data in Settlements.</p> <p>This CP has been raised from SIR R1736 'Inconsistency in Pool Documentation in respect of Metering System Proving Test'.</p>	
<p>Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p><u>BSCP502</u> Add a new step to process 3.5 'Issuing Results of Proving Test (All Methods of Proving)', numbered 3.5.5.5 in the Interface and Timetable Information as follows:</p> <p>When: If no notification received from MOA on outcome of proving test. Action: Contact MOA to confirm status of proving test. Proceed to 3.5.5.2 or 3.5.5.3 as appropriate. From: HHDC. To: MOA. Information Required: D0005 Instruction on Action. Method: Manual.</p> <p>Corresponding changes will be required to the Workflow Diagrams.</p> <p><u>PSL130</u> Replace paragraph 1.4.2.3 with the following:</p> <p>'Where the Half Hourly Data Collector receives no notification from its Associated Meter Operator Agent of the status of a proving test/re-test, it shall request confirmation of such status and will only submit Meter Period Value data into Settlements in the event of a successful proving test/re-test.'</p> <p>There will be an impact on the <u>BSC SVA Data Catalogue</u> which will require the occurrence of</p>	

the HHDC to MOA to be added to the 'Source Document' section for the D0005 dataflow.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>	
The current process allows HHDCs to process unproven data for Settlements. This CP will resolve this problem and ensure that data being entered into Settlement has been proven.
