Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> BSCP504 3.2.6.10 states: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • that the new DC must obtain a valid meter read within SSD-5 and SSD+5 window and send the report to the New Supplier, PDSO and the old NHHDC (if applicable) <p>We believe this wording is ambiguous and it should be specified where this requirement is Applicable</p> <p>In addition,</p> <p>3.2.6.11 states</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) If valid meter reading obtained outside SSD-5 and SSD+5 window but before SSD+8 or b) If no valid meter reading obtained by SSD+8 <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • then calculate a deemed meter reading for the SSD, based on the historic data provided by the old NHHDC (where applicable) and the METD provided by the MOA. . • Send this meter reading. <p>This is further complicated by the fact that many DCs who have not received a meter reading on a D0086 dataflow by SSD+8 are using their own historical data related to when they previously owned the supply. Whilst we accept that the DC is displaying a good intent to help customers receive timely accounts there is a significant risk that poor data will be used resulting in disputed reads.</p> <p>In addition, there may have been several months or longer between each customer transfer in which a number of meter readings may have been processed. Without this more recent data, the new DC is running the risk of entering poor data into settlements. To compound this there may also have been a meter change of which the new DC may not be aware and this could lead to, at best, inconsistencies and at worst, stuck registrations.</p>	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> Amend BSCP 504 to state that in the Change of Supplier process, the new DC must wait for valid historical meter reading data from the old DC prior to generating a deemed D0086 dataflow.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i> There is a risk to settlements with the inappropriate use of historic data.
