<p>Title <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>Clarify the NHH Deemed Reading Rules at Final Reconciliation</p>	
<p>Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i></p> <p>Change PSL120 'Non Half Hourly Data Collection' and BSCP504 'Non Half Hourly Data Collection for SVA Metering Systems Registered in SMRS' to clarify the rules which apply when an Estimated Annual Consumption (EAC) has been provided for the Final Reconciliation Run (RF).</p> <p>There are three requirements (two in the PSL and one in the BSCP) relating to the rules for deeming:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Paragraph 1.5.4.2 d of PSL120 states that: <i>'when a meter has been read and the Final Volume Allocation Reconciliation Run for the previous reading date has taken place a meter reading may be Deemed for a Settlement Day for which the Final Volume Allocation Reconciliation Run has yet to take place;'</i> 2. Paragraph 1.5.7.10 of PSL120 states that: <i>'Where an Estimated Annual Consumption has been used for a Final Reconciliation Volume Allocation Run and a meter reading is obtained by the Non Half Hourly Data Collector after that Reconciliation Volume Allocation Run, the Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall calculate a Deemed meter reading for the last Settlement Day (or one shortly thereafter) for which an Estimated Annual Consumption was submitted for inclusion in a Final Reconciliation Volume Allocation Run, using the Estimation of Annual Consumption (EAC/AA) System or any equivalent Certified system. The Non Half Hourly Data Collector shall then calculate a new Annualised Advance for the period between that Deemed meter reading and the meter reading obtained after the relevant Reconciliation Volume Allocation Run and pass the new Estimated Annual Consumption or Annualised Advance to the relevant Non Half Hourly Data Aggregator.'</i> 3. Paragraph 3 of Appendix 4.5 'Deemed Meter Advance Calculation' of BSCP504 states that: <i>'When a meter has been read and the Final Reconciliation Volume Allocation Run for the previous reading date has taken place a meter reading may be deemed for a Settlement Day for which the Final Reconciliation Volume Allocation Run has yet to take place.'</i> 	

Unfortunately, the first paragraph (reference 1.5.4.2 d) states that the NHHDC 'may deem', whereas the second paragraph (reference 1.5.7.10) states that the NHHDC 'shall deem' a reading. The BSCP is consistent with paragraph 1.5.4.2 d of PSL120.

In line with paragraph 4.3.21 of Annex S2 'Supplier Volume Allocation Rules', the NHHDC shall deem a reading when an EAC was provided for the Final Reconciliation Run.

This CP therefore proposes to remove the existing ambiguity.

Proposed Solution(s) *(mandatory by originator)*

The following changes are proposed:

1. In PSL120, replace paragraph 1.5.4.2 d with paragraph 1.5.7.10 and remove paragraph 1.5.7.10.
2. Change BSCP504 so that Appendix 4.5 'Deemed Meter Advance Calculation' and its cross-references are removed on the basis that this section repeats text covered in PSL120 or the BSC.

Justification for Change *(mandatory by originator)*

Ensures that the PSL is consistent with the BSC and that duplicate requirements are removed from BSCP504.

The issue referred to above was raised by the BSC Auditor on 30th October 2001 on the basis that a number of NHHDCs, in the previous auditing period, had an issue raised against them relating to the requirement to deem a read at RF (most had no process). It is therefore proposed that changes are incorporated prior to the next Audit review which will be undertaken in March 2002.
