<b>Description of Change</b> <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>  The Code Section P 2.2.2 and 3.2.2 states that an Authorisation Termination is effective when received by the ECVAA, however BSCP71 states that it can only be effective 1 Calendar Day after receipt by the ECVAA.  This Change Proposal has been raised to address inconsistencies initially identified by the NETA Programme and subsequently reviewed by ELEXON. (IRP CP018)
