Description of Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>	
<p>This Change Proposal has been raised to address inconsistencies initially identified by the NETA Programme and subsequently reviewed by ELEXON. (IRP CP025)</p> <p>Inconsistencies 341, 342 & 343 (Log refs. URS_CDCA 52, 53 & 54) Section R, 5.6.2 of the BSC Code says that for each Volume Allocation Run the CDCA shall ensure that it makes use of any relevant data that has been adjusted or revised since the Initial Run. In section 5.6.3 the Code explains that the relevant information includes registration data, Meter Technical Details, Aggregation Rules, Line Loss Factors and metered data.</p> <p>The CDCA URS sections F026 and F027 say that adjusted metered data should be taken into account, and omits the other information types.</p>	
Proposed Solution(s) <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>	
Amend CDCA URS sections F026 and F027 to make clear that the CDCA should carry out a Volume Allocation Re-run when any changes have been made to the following: Metered Data, Line Loss Factors, Aggregation Rules, Registration Data and Meter Technical Details.	
Justification for Change <i>(mandatory by originator)</i>	
To remove inconsistencies between the BSC Code v.1.1 section R and the CDCA URS v.2.3. Currently the CDCA does not take into account any other data that has been revised since the Initial Run.
