<p><b>Title:   Removal of restriction on Polling Interval</b></p>	
<p><b>Description of Change</b></p> <p>At Go Live it was recognised that PCSec seemed to have a ‘memory leakage’ problem. This defect caused significant problems when PCSec was used with a sub-second polling interval as originally specified. A work around was therefore agreed to increase the polling interval to 10 seconds in order to deliver a useable version of PCSec for Go Live.</p> <p>It is understood by ELEXON that a technical solution to this defect has been found by Logica. Consequently, it is proposed that the polling interval is set to the original sub-second interval to reduce the risk that files miss Gate Closure due to the slow polling of outbound files.</p>	
<p><b>Proposed Solution(s)</b></p> <p>To re-configure PCSec with a sub-second polling interval as originally intended as part of a future release of PCSec.</p>	
<p><b>Justification for Change</b></p> <p>The change described in this Change Proposal will provide participants with a more useable version of PCSec.</p> <p>This change was proposed by the NETA Programme. ELEXON undertook to take this forward after NETA Go Live.</p>
