

## Change Proposal – F40/01 (Page 1 of 2)

**Title** Alignment of the use of Participation Capacity in BSCP65 with the BSC

**Description of Change** (mandatory by originator)

The use of terminology relating to Participation Capacity in BSCP65 4.1 is inconsistent with the Code A1.3.1.  
*Proposed amendments are detailed in Attachment 1.*

***This Change Proposal has been raised from NCR323 version 2.***

**Proposed Solution(s)** (mandatory by originator)

### **BSCP65 Version 2**

- i) Form BSCP65/4.1, Party Registration Application / Change of Registration Details Form, to be updated to reflect the Participation Capacity terminology used in the Code, Section A paragraph 1.3.1. A sub-section under Trading Party to be incorporated to reflect Logica categories, CVA Metering System Registrant, Non-physical and Interconnector User.
- ii) Update the Route Map to show that DSO, TC and IA register as Parties with the CRA after Accession and that the IEA is classified as another Trading Party i.e. one not required to register BM Units and meters but a Party who is allocated Energy Accounts.

**Justification for Change** (mandatory by originator)

Ensure that Parties register in the correct Participation Capacity under BSCP65, as required in the Code. If Parties were to register in Participation Capacities not recognised by the Code it may lead to confusion for Parties and Service Providers and ultimately may prohibit Parties from undertaking certain activities eg under the current Participation Capacities covered in BSCP65 Supplier is not seen as a Participation Capacity.

This is currently part of Workaround 001, where Logica need to be able to identify the exact type of Trading Party an Application Party / current Party is seeking to register as, this is recorded in BSC Systems to ensure that the correct set of interface testing is or has been undertaken.

Some organisations wish to receive reports available to all Parties and may try to register, under the current version of BSCP65, as a Party without registering any assets. Currently under the Code if a Party does not register a Metering System, BM Unit, submit Notifications or appoint an Interconnector Administrator or Interconnector Error Administrator the Party shall, after a 6 month period, either automatically cease to be a Party or notice shall be given by BSCCO to that Party unless otherwise agreed by the Panel, Section A paragraph 2.6. When registering Parties in BSC System all Parties are deemed to be 'BSC Parties' 'BPs' along with the Participation Capacity identified in the Code, Section A paragraph 1.3.1.
