



Final CP Report – CP1399

Date	7 October 2013
Purpose of paper	For Information
Summary	This report provides details of the background, solution, impacts, industry views and the PAB's, ISG's, SVG's and TDC's final views on its decision to Approve CP1399 'Business Process Operations (BPO) Service rebranding'.

1. Why change?

Background

The name of the company that provides the Business Process Operations (BPO) Service for the BSC Central Systems has changed from Logica to CGI.

What is the issue?

There are several references to "Logica" and "EPFAL"¹ in BSC Configurable Items (CIs), which are redundant.

We raised Housekeeping CP² (Change Proposal) CP1399 'Business Process Operations (BPO) Service rebranding' on 6 September 2013 to address this issue.

2. Solution

CP1399 proposes to amend the relevant BSC CIs. The changes will:

- wherever possible, remove reference to the company name (so that future changes are not required if the company name changes again); or
- replace the company name with:
 - a more relevant reference (where this needs to be distinguished), or
 - "CGI" (for email addresses to ensure that participants have the correct and up-to-date contact details).

The CIs impacted are:

- owned by the Imbalance Settlement Group (ISG);
- jointly owned by the ISG and Supplier Volume Allocation Group (SVG);
- owned by the SVG but operated by the Performance Assurance Board (PAB); or
- owned by the Trading Disputes Committee (TDC).

As such, we will ask all of the relevant Panel Committees to approve CP1399, or to endorse the CP in the case of the PAB. The impacted CIs, the relevant Panel Committees and proposed changes are as follows:

3. Impacts and costs

Central impacts and costs

CP1399 will require minor updates to the CIs listed below and will have no system impacts. CGI is paying for the changes and so there will be no ELEXON costs to be passed on to BSC Parties.

Party impacts and costs

Housekeeping CPs do not require a CP Impact Assessment as Housekeeping Changes do not impact participants.

4. Implementation approach

CP1399 is targeted for implementation on 7 November 2013 as part of the November 2013 BSC Release.

5. Final decision

PAB/ISG/SVG/TDC's final views

ELEXON presented CP1399 to the PAB ([PAB152/04](#)) for its endorsement at its meeting on 26 September; and to the ISG ([ISG149/04](#)), SVG ([SVG152/08](#)) and TDC ([TDC183/02](#)) for their approval on 24 September, 1 October and 3 October 2013 respectively.

ELEXON outlined the background, solution, impacts and industry views to the PAB, ISG, SVG and TDC on CP1399. ELEXON invited each committee to consider the report and to reach a decision on whether to endorse (in the case of PAB) or approve (in the case of ISG/SVG/TDC) the CP and its proposed implementation.

At its meeting on 24 September 2013, an ISG Member questioned if there had been any functionary changes in CP1399. ELEXON advised that the changes were for housekeeping purposes only.

The ISG Member also questioned if the cost of CP1399 would have been more if CGI were not picking up the costs. ELEXON commented that CGI had carried out most of the redlined changes. ELEXON also advised that for any document changes, it would normally estimate it to be one man day of effort, which currently equates to £240.

At its meeting on 3 October 2013, a TDC Member asked for clarification on one of the changes to BSCP14. ELEXON confirmed that this was one of the additional Housekeeping Changes that it had captured, referred to in the paper.



Final Report

PAB and SVG Members raised no comments or questions regarding CP1399.

Final Decision

The PAB endorsed and the ISG, SVG and TDC approved CP1399 for implementation on 7 November 2013 as part of the November 2013 BSC Systems Release. The Committees endorsed or approved all of the amendments to the Configurable Items, as follows:

- the PAB endorsed changes to BSCP533, BSCP533 Appendix A and BSCP536;
- the ISG approved changes to BSCP70, the CVA Data Catalogue, CVA Data Catalogue Annex A, CVA Data Catalogue Annex B, CVA Data Catalogue Annex C and FAA IDD Part 1;
- the SVG approved changes to BSCP70, BSCP533, BSCP533 Appendix A and BSCP536; and
- the TDC approved changes to BSCP14.
