



Final CP Report – CP1402

Purpose of paper	For Information
Summary	This report provides details of the background, solution, impacts, industry views and the SVG's final views on its decision to approve Change Proposal (CP) 1402 'Aligning the Deliverables in the Service Description for Profile Administration with the Data Analyst contract'.

1. Why Change

Background

Section 5 'Deliverables' of the Service Description for Profile Administration describes the process, for each Settlement Year, by which the Profile Administrator (PrA) delivers various Technical Product Deliverables¹ on the Delivery Date(s) as defined in the Data Analysis Plan.

What is the issue?

The PrA Service Description needs updating to reflect and match all the reporting deliverables defined in the Data Analyst contract, as the Service Description does not currently cover all of the deliverables produced.²

ELEXON raised Change Proposal (CP) 1402 'Aligning the Deliverables in the Service Description for Profile Administration with the Data Analyst contract' on 9 October 2013 to address this issue.

2. Solution

For consistency, this CP seeks to amend section 5 of the PrA Service Description to align the list of Document Deliverables with those produced under the Data Analyst contract.

Attachment A contains the full proposed redlined changes to the Service Description.

3. Impacts and Costs

Central impacts and costs

CP1402 will require updates to the PrA Service Description. The following table shows the estimated ELEXON implementation effort:

4. Implementation Approach

CP1402 is targeted for implementation on 26 June 2014 as part of the June 2014 BSC Systems Release.

5. Industry Views

ELEXON issued CP1402 for CP Impact Assessment via CPC00734. We received four responses, of which three agreed with the change and one was neutral.

8. Final Decision

SVG's Final Views and Decision

ELEXON presented CP1402 to the SVG at its meeting on 7 January 2014 for approval³.

ELEXON presented the background, solution, impacts and industry views for CP1402. ELEXON invited the SVG to approve CP1402 for implementation in the June 2014 Release.

The SVG noted that the CP would not change, and would simply clarify, the existing Profile Administration service.

Final Decision

The SVG approved CP1402 for implementation on 26 June 2014 as part of the June 2014 BSC Systems Release and agreed the proposed amendments to the Profile Administration Service Description.
