1 Why Change?

Background

Change Proposal (CP) 1433 '[Clarification of which Metering Systems are captured by the P272 requirements](#)' amended [Balancing and Settlement Code Procedure \(BSCP\) 516 'Allocation of Profile Classes and SSCs'](#) and was implemented as part of the June 2015 BSC Release. CP1433 clarified the registration requirements for non-domestic Import Customers without an Advanced Meter and those that remain in Profile Classes 5-8. This addressed a lack of clarity around the implementation of [P272 'Mandatory Half Hourly Settlement for Profile Classes 5-8'](#).

What is the issue?

When considering CP1433, the SVG was aware that the P272 Implementation Date was under review and so could change. It agreed to approve CP1433 as it stood, and to progress a Housekeeping CP if the P272 Implementation Date subsequently changed. Since the decision on CP1433, the Authority has extended the P272 Implementation Date to 1 April 2017, and so the date references introduced by CP1433 need amending accordingly.

2 Solution

Proposed solution

ELEXON raised Housekeeping [CP1445 'BSCP516 alignment with revised P272 Implementation Date'](#). It proposes to amend all references to the P272 Implementation Date introduced to BSCP516 by CP1433 from "1 April 2016" to "1 April 2017".

CP1445 will also remove footnote 2, which appears in references to the requirement for Half Hourly Settlement of Profile Class 5-8 Metering Systems with Advanced Meters from 1 April 2016. The original CP1433 footnote wording stated that "This requirement is being implemented by approved BSC Modification P272". As well as changing "1 April 2016" to "1 April 2017" throughout the BSCP, CP1445 will delete this footnote. This is because, by the time we implement CP1445, the implementation of [P322 'Revised Implementation Arrangements for Mandatory Half Hourly Settlement for Profile Classes 5-8'](#) on 3 August 2015 will have already mandated this requirement.

Proposer's rationale

This Housekeeping CP provides clarity to ensure that there is no confusion with the registration requirements in BSCP516.

Proposed redlining

Attachment A contains the proposed changes to BSCP516 to deliver the CP1445 solution.

Recommended Implementation Date

The recommended Implementation Date for CP1445 is **11 August 2015** as part of a Standalone Release. This is five Working Days following the SVG decision. These changes should be made as soon as possible to ensure that there is clarity in the BSCP.

- **AGREE** that CP1445 should be progressed as a Housekeeping CP;
- **APPROVE** the proposed changes to BSCP516 for CP1445; and
- **APPROVE** CP1445 for implementation on 11 August 2015 as part of a Standalone Release.
