About This Document

This document is the Change Proposal (CP) Assessment Report for CP1481 which ELEXON will present to the Supplier Volume Allocation (SVG) and Performance Assurance Board (PAB) at their meetings on 3 January 2017 and 26 January 2017, respectively. The SVG and PAB will consider the issue and proposed solution, determine if the change is a Housekeeping Change, and then make decision on whether to approve CP1481.

There are two parts to this document:

- This is the main document. It provides details of the solution, impacts, costs, and proposed implementation approach.
- Attachment A contains the proposed redlined changes to deliver the CP1481 solution.

1 Why Change?



Approved Modification P339

The Panel approved [P339 'Introduction of new Consumption Component Classes for Measurement Classes E-G'](#) at its meeting on 8 December 2016 ([BSC Panel 261/06](#)). P339 will introduce new Consumption Component Classes (CCCs) and also redefines some existing CCCs. [Balancing and Settlement Code Procedure \(BSCP\) 536 'Supplier Charges'](#) has references to specific CCC IDs which required updating as a result of P339.

What is the issue?

After approval of the P339 and the corresponding redlining, an error in the redlining to BSCP536 was identified.

The approved redlined changes to BSCP536 incorrectly redefined a definition to include both Active Export and Active Import, where it previously only included Active Import. The intent of P339 was not to change the definition but simply to remove the references to specific CCC IDs. There will be no change to the calculation of Supplier Charges.

Housekeeping Change

BSCP40 defines a Housekeeping Change as "the correction of manifest errors, minor errors and inconsistencies, including typographical errors (e.g. punctuation errors, spelling mistakes, incorrect font, incorrect capitalisation) incorrect cross-referencing, and the removal of redundant text."

2 Solution

Proposed solution

[CP1481 'Housekeeping Change to BSCP536 following approval of P339'](#) was raised by ELEXON on 14 December 2016. CP1481 proposes to include the words 'Active Import' in the approved redlining for BSCP536 to correct a manifest error.

Proposer's rationale

This change proposes to amend this manifest error to avoid any confusion.

Proposed redlining

The proposed redlining to BSCP536 can be found in Attachment A. For clarity the approved changes under P339 are shown in red and the additional text for CP1481 is shown in blue.
